

April 16, 2018

Marina Committee meeting April, 11, 2018, Meeting started 6pm.

In attendance; Greg Marquette, Bob Densic, Jerry Staczek, Jessica Benson, Tyler Kolb.

Items discussed:

- 1) Wall dock holders will not be able to drill or attach any items into the concrete raised walkways. Grills and dock boxes will only be allowed to be anchored into the asphalt. Boaters who attach equipment to the walls will have the equipment removed and their security deposit forfeited for the season.
- 2) Dock holders on the West wall will be required to place their grill & dock boxes on top of the walkways. However, they will not be able to secure them to the walkways. These items will not be allowed to be placed on the asphalt due to the need to maintain quick access for emergency responders or City work crews.
- 3) The honey wagon will be placed on the East wall, last dock by the barge, to allow boaters access to the pump out equipment. This will be a trial placement to ensure there are no odor or other complaints. Cost of pump out will be \$5.00. Boat owners will be responsible for doing their own pump out.
- 4) Torn and ripped banners will be replaced.
- 5) Dock assignments were made. One pontoon boat will be relocated, due to large size, to a temporary dock on A dock.
- 6) Dock holders will be allowed to drill into the dock poles, but not the docks, to assist with mooring needs.
- 7) Guard coverage will be provided as such:
May 1st thru May 15th will be 3rd shift only.
May 16 thru Sept 30th will be 2nd & 3rd shift only with no day shift Monday thru Thurs, only 2nd and 3rd shifts).
There will be full coverage (all 3 shifts) on Fridays thru Sundays, including holidays.
Oct 1st thru Oct 15th will be 3rd shift only.
- 8) Missing life rings are to be replaced.
- 9) Ice is to be priced at \$1.50 per bag.
- 10) Port-o-Potties in the main parking lot (Hannum Ave) are to be placed with the doors facing West, or towards the marina guard shack for enhanced security.
- 11) Open containers of alcoholic beverages are allowed to be carried between boats and docks within the marina area. Open containers are allowed on the stone walkway. However, no open containers of alcoholic beverages will be allowed past the south side (park area side) of the stone walkway. Boaters and guest can transverse between all wall dock and floating dock areas with open containers.
- 12) Discussed moving forward with placing jet ski docks along the East wall for next season. This will be discussed further after receiving input from Mrs. Freeman.
- 13) Discussed the need to start planning for repair or replacement of West and East wall docks due to age and condition.
- 14) As the City Facilities portion of the meeting. Discussed replacing the banners in the downtown boulevard with new fabric banners, vs the vinyl banners. The fabric banners will last longer than

the vinyl. The committee has no problem replacing the banners, however the money to do so must not come out of the marina fund.
