**Rossford City Facilities, Parks and Marina Committee meeting**

In Attendance, Councilman Staczek, Marquette and Minarcin, City Administrator Mike Scott, Police Chief Glen Goss. Meeting came to order on July 3, 2015 at 5pm in Council chambers.

Primary discussion centered around how long safe harbor, granted to other neighboring community boaters who's docks have been damaged by the flood waters, should remain in effect . The committee decided that a July 15<sup>th</sup> date for ending safe harbor would be sufficient time for the affected boaters to determine their future dockage arrangements.

The committee looked at the current rate change structure in place. On July 15<sup>th</sup>, the dock rates are reduced by \$100.00 for the remaining half of the season. Currently the marina has approximately 14 unrented docks, as compared to being sold out last year. Councilman Staczek stated that in years past the rate was reduced by 50%. He believes that to remain competitive in this area of the river, the marina needs to be able to offer more and encouraged the committee to consider reverting to 50% rate. The committee voted 2 to 1 to remain at the current rate structure.

Parking was addressed. The committee requested that Chief Goss have the Marina Guards pay closer attention to parking. Specifically ensuring fishermen, marina guards and dock renters park in the correct areas and that the "No parking/stripped areas remain clear.

Meeting ended 5:30pm.
