

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS
ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING
HELD DECEMBER 5, 2005

The first order of business was to swear in the newly elected council members. Mayor Verbosky first swore in incumbent council members Richard Kovach, Caroline Eckel, and James D. Richards and then newly elected member Leonard Michaels.

Mark Radwanski was sworn in as City Treasurer

The meeting was then called to order by Mayor William Verbosky Jr. and was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: Richards, Oberdorf, Eckel, Marquette, Hermes, Michaels, and Kovach all present.

SELECTION OF PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL: Mr. Richards moved and Mrs. Eckel seconded the nomination of Larry Oberdorf to be President of Council. Mr. Hermes moved and Mr. Oberdorf seconded the nomination of Mr. Richards to be President of Council. Mr. Marquette moved and Mr. Oberdorf seconded the nomination of Rick Kovach to be President of Council. The vote on the nomination of Mr. Oberdorf was Richards, Oberdorf, Eckel, and Michaels aye. Marquette, Hermes, and Kovach nay. Mr. Oberdorf is elected President of Council by a 4-3 vote.

APPOINTMENT OF CLERK OF COUNCIL: Mr. Richards moved and Mr. Oberdorf seconded the motion to reappoint Robert Watrol as Clerk of Council. Vote on the motion all ayes. Mr. Watrol is reappointed as Clerk of Council.

Mayor Verbosky then submitted his appointments of standing committees of council. These are as follows:

JUDICIARY, BUILDING & INSURANCE – Chairman Mr. Marquette, Mr. Hermes and Mr. Kovach

PUBLIC WORKS & UTILITIES – Chairman Mr. Kovach, Mrs. Eckel and Mr. Michaels

BUDGET, WAYS & MEANS – Chairman Mr. Hermes, Mr. Oberdorf and Mr. Richards

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT – Chairman Mr. Richards, Mr. Kovach and Mr. Michaels

PUBLIC SAFETY – Chairman Mrs. Eckel, Mr. Hermes and Mr. Richards

RECREATION – Chairman Mr. Oberdorf, Mrs. Eckel and Mr. Marquette

MARINA – Chairman Mr. Michaels, Mr. Marquette and Mr. Oberdorf

Mayor Verbosky made no appointments to the negotiation committee at this time until further discussions with council take place. He is considering keeping the negotiations in-house with the administration and possibly a member of council

Mr. Richards moved and Mr. Marquette seconded the motion to adjourn. All ayes. Motion carried.
